You can find a swimsuit, key chain, school backpack, tropical mousepad, swim goggles, water filter, and many other out of the way and hard to find items at the shop.



## Grand Cayman Trip Review

Our August trip to Grand Cayman proved to be memorable for everyone. Despite warnings concerning tropical storm Chantal, we received only slight wind, rain and high seas on Sunday. Diving resumed on Monday with Stingray City, where we fed a multitude of Southern Stingray and two friendly Green Moray eels.

Diving conditions were fine and the pool was open for the rest of the week, so we made up for lost time with daily dives and a night dive. We encountered stingray, eel, black coral, lobster, and even a hammerhead shark. We saw clouds of fish life on every dive.

The island itself is beautiful, with lovely tropical foliage. Our group toured the beautiful Cayman botanical gardens, which is an enjoyable and informative side trip. The Turtle Farm was another favorite destination, where we were able to see turtles in all stages of growth.

The dive site next to the Turtle Farm proved to be a favorite shore dive as well, since it has a very enjoyable mini-wall.

Ocean Frontiers is an extremely professional dive operation. Once you set up your gear, they take charge of it for you. They rinse and hang it for you each night, and then carry it to the boat each day. The boats are spacious, well set up, and convenient for diving. It was a pleasure to be pampered by our dive hosts.

Grand Cayman continues to live up to its reputation, and is well worth a visit. The diving is superb.

## Annual Service

How long has it been since your Reg, BC, and tanks have been serviced?

Remember, your gear is life-support equipment, and it needs to be serviced at least once a year, more often if it receives heavy duty use.

Tanks should be visually inspected yearly and hydro tested every 5 years. SIS is a fully certified tank hydro inspection facility. We can visually inspect your tanks, and hydro test them when needed.

Be sure that you thoroughly clean your BC and reg after every dive, and store them in a cool, dry place. Bring them in to be serviced on a yearly schedule, or whenever you notice a problem.

It's important that you allow time for service, too. We're a full service shop, and often have many sets of gear in for annual maintenance. Sometimes we may have to order special parts as well. Don't wait until the day before a trip for a complete inspection and rebuild of your gear, or you may be disappointed!
